The successful applicants will be required to undertake the nationally recognised RGR30419 Certificate III Racing Services (Cadet Steward) qualification. The program will be delivered both on and off the job primarily within the Stewards Department based at Harness Racing NSW Head Office in Bankstown.

A full-time vacancy exists in the Bankstown office for the position of Cadet Steward.

Reporting to the Chairman of Stewards the successful applicant will be required to undertake the following duties:

- Attend harness race meetings within NSW
- Work on Steward panels
- Undertake office administration duties inclusive of Handicapping & Registration
- Given the nature of the position, you will be required to work nights and/or weekends as well as Public Holidays

The successful applicant will be provided with on and off the job training and may be required to undertake future studies to advance their career as well as being relocated to a regional area if required.

The Applicant should have the following skills and knowledge:

- A NSW drivers licence or the ability to obtain a licence is essential.
- Possess knowledge of or have a keen interest in the Harness Racing Industry and an interest in regulatory matters.
- Knowledge and experience with working with horses is an advantage but not essential.
- Applicants must encompass integrity, be highly motivated, have a high work ethic and be competent

  these skills.
