CONCESSION DRIVER TERMS & CONDITIONS

BACKGROUND

- 1.1. This policy establishes the term of a drivers claim, what is a win, the threshold of wins allowed prior to losing the right to claim, the minimum front of the races where a claim can be used and the restrictions on races where a claim cannot be used.
- 1.2. Former changes to previous versions stemmed from a decision by the HRA Executive to standardise conditions that are applied in each state or territory that determine the term of the concessions driver's licence and what counts as a win.
- 1.3. Additional changes were made in 2012 to the minimum fronts (as a three month trial) and the term. With respect to the term Concession Drivers that did not win 50 races 5 years from attainment of an initial B Grade Drivers Licence or the driver reaches the age of 23, whichever is the latter, gained a term extension of two years or up to 50 wins, whichever occurs first.
- 1.4. In 2014 further changes were made to the minimum fronts to allow them to come in line with the Mares Drop Back Policy and other jurisdiction minimum fronts.
- 1.5. In October 2018, changes were made in relation to the definition of a 'Term'. In addition, the restrictions stating 'A race with prizemoney ≥ \$30,000' will now include (with the exception of level racing) which is the current position taken with Menangle level racing. Furthermore, the Definitions 'Career (Standard) Race' will be updated from \$3500 to \$4500.
- 1.6. Following an internal review, changes were made in relation to the extension of the concession claim to be amended from 50 wins to 100 wins.

POLICY

The Concession Driver terms and conditions are:

Term	Condition
Term	5 years from attainment of an initial B Grade Drivers Licence.
Term	Condition
What is a Win?	A win will count whether or not a concession has been claimed. (A dead-heat does not count as a win).
Wins	250 (for the Term)
Term Extension	Should a driver not win 100 races during the Term then they will receive a two year Term Extension.
	The Term Extension will end upon whichever of the following occurs first:
	a) a driver wins the 100th race of their career
	b) at the conclusion of the two years of the Term Extension
	Term Extensions are not retrospective and commence with drivers coming out of their Term on 1 December 2018.
Minimum Front	M1 C1 R1 – TM0 T1 TR1
Restrictions (Claim cannot be used)	M0, C0 & R0 front races plus T0 & TR0 front races
	2YO & 3YO races
	Special Handicap Conditions
	Discretionary Handicaps
	Claiming Races
	NSW Breeders Challenge Races
	Classic Events
	A race with prizemoney ≥ \$30,000 (with the exception of level racing)
	Races specified from time to time by HRNSW in conjunction with the conducting club

All conditions are subject to annual review.

DEFINITIONS

Career Penalty A penalty of one class imposed to adjust the Career Class of a

horse.

Career (Standard) Race A race with stakemoney greater than \$4,500 but not exceeding the

threshold amount for a Metropolitan race

Dead Heats A driver shall not incur any penalty as provided by these Rules for

dead-heating for first placing in a race.

Drivers Concession A horse driven by a concession driver claiming a concession will

have its classification reduced by one class for that race.

Graduation Penalty A penalty of one class imposed to adjust the Graduation Class of a

horse.

Graduation Race A race with stakemoney greater than \$2,000 but not exceeding

\$4,500.

Metropolitan Penalty A penalty of one class imposed to adjust the Metropolitan Class of a

horse.

Metropolitan Race A race with specified stakemoney in excess of the metropolitan

threshold amount that is set by a State's Controlling Body for application within the State for the 12 months period commencing $1^{\rm st}$

September each year.

NB. The metropolitan threshold amounts set by the respective State

Controlling Bodies for the 2018/19 racing season are:

NSW - \$14,999

Queensland - \$14,999 South Australia - \$14,999 Tasmania - \$14,999 Victoria - \$14,999

Western Australia - \$14,999

Out Driving Claim When a concession driver wins their final concession claim race in a

year at a meeting where they have further driving engagements, the driver will be permitted to claim the relevant concession/s for the remainder of such meeting and any other meeting on the same day

only.

Penalty Free Race A race with stakemoney of \$2,000 or less.
