DRESS REGULATIONS

1 PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to outline the stabling area dress regulations for licensed persons at all New South Wales harness racing tracks following on from the successful implementation of the same regulations during the 2010 Inter Dominion.

2 FEMALE DRESS

- 2.1 Women are expected to maintain a suitable standard of dress while adhering to OH&S regulations.
- 2.2 The following attire is deemed as acceptable:
- (i) Dresses and skirts of a respectable length.
 - (ii) Dress slacks, dress jeans or tailored 3/4 pants worn with a modest blouse or top.
 - (iii) Enclosed shoes (sneakers are permitted so long as they are clean and in good condition).
- 2.3 The following attire is deemed as unacceptable:
- (i) T-Shirts.
 - (ii) Bathers, bikini tops or similar beach attire.
 - (iii) Track pants.
 - (iv) Ragged, tattered, unclean or torn clothing (including designer "tears").
 - (v) Clothing with racist or offensive slogans.
 - (vi) Thongs, dilapidated shoes, ugg boots or slippers.

3 MALE DRESS

- 3.1 Men are expected to maintain a suitable standard of dress while adhering to OH&S regulations.
- 3.2 The following attire is deemed as acceptable:
- (i) A collared shirt must be worn, irrespective of whether or not a jacket is worn over the shirt.
 - (ii) Trousers or dress jeans.
 - (iii) Enclosed shoes (sneakers are permitted so long as they are clean and in good condition).
- 3.3 The following attire is deemed as unacceptable:
- (i) T-shirts.
 - (ii) Board shorts or similar beach attire.
 - (iii) Track pants or overalls.
 - (iv) Ragged, tattered, unclean or torn clothing (including designer "tears").
 - (v) Clothing with racist or offensive slogans.
 - (vi) Thongs, dilapidated shoes, ugg boots or slippers.

4 FAILURE TO COMPLY

- 4.1 Persons that fail to comply with this policy may be denied admission into the stabling area and/or face disciplinary action from Stewards.
