NSW Penalty Exempt Drivers Series

BACKGROUND

- 1. Under the amended Australian Handicapping Rules, each state may conduct three (3) Penalty Exempt Drivers' series per season comprising up to six (6) races per Series plus one (1) or more Drivers Series for Concession Drivers but limited in total to no more than twenty four (24) races per season.
- 2. Under the amended Australian Handicapping Rules the NSW Rising Stars can now be scheduled as one of the Concession Drivers Series' and therefore it provides an opportunity for another six (6) race Series to be conducted.

DRIVERS SERIES'

Three Penalty Exempt Drivers Series'

- 1. A Metropolitan/Provincial Drivers and a Country Drivers Series will continue to be conducted by Clubs as set out in the Schedule below as two (2) of the three (3) series permissible under the Australian Handicapping Rules.
- 2. All Clubs wishing to conduct a race within the appropriate Series must make application to HRNSW by mid August, prior to the season that the Series' are to be conducted.
- 3. Upon application, a Club that ran a race the previous season will automatically be granted the race the next season.
- 4. If a Club does not seek to conduct a race the next season the opportunity to conduct a race within the appropriate Series will be offered, on merit, to another Club that has made application.
 - Due to the rule changes the Western Districts Junior Drivers event at Dubbo and the Junior Driver Invitational at Orange will be considered within the Concession Driver Series'.
- 5. The Indigenous Drivers Series is to form the third Drivers Series permissible under the Australian Handicapping Rules. The NSWHRC is to program up to five (5) heats around the State with the Final to be conducted at Tabcorp Park Menangle annually at the Fishers Ghost Meeting.



POLICY STATEMENT

Concession Drivers Series

- 1. The NSW Rising Starts Series is to comprise ten (10) races of the Concession Drivers Series'.
- 2. Clubs will be able to tender annually for the additional fourteen (14) available races.
- 3. Clubs wishing to conduct a race within the Concession Drivers Series must make application to HRNSW by mid August, prior to the season that the Series' are to be conducted.
- 4. HRNSW will allocate the Concession Drivers Series races annually on merit.

POLICY

ALL DRIVERS INVITATION SERIES' (excluding NSW Rising Stars)

- 1. Any driver that has been found guilty of any offence resulting in a disqualification will be ineligible to compete in any Drivers Invitation Series for a period of two (2) years from the time of the reallocation of their drivers licence.
- 2. Clubs are to advise the HRNSW Racing Office which Drivers are participating in the Drivers Invitation event one (1) month prior to acceptance time.
- 3. Once a Club has notified the Drivers, HRNSW will advise stakeholders via an Official Notice.
- 4. An invited driver shall not drive a horse such driver normally drives or works.
- 5. A horse trained by an invited driver is ineligible to compete.
- 6. A horse owned by an invited driver is ineligible to compete.
- 7. Drivers are to be allocated their drives by manual ballot.
- 8. Any variations to points 4, 5, 6, and 7 must be written into the individual race conditions.
- 9. HRNSW has the right to amend/vary the conditions of any individual race within any Penalty Exempt Drivers Series.
