

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) - RESTRICTIONS STAY AT HOME RULES PERSONS WHO ATTENDED NEWCASTLE, LAKE MACQUARIE, MAITLAND, PORT STEPHENS, CESSNOCK, DUNGOG, SINGLETON

AND MUSWELLBROOK LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS.

AUGUST 6 2021

In addition to the lockdown orders imposed by the NSW Government from 5pm yesterday in relation to the Newcastle, Lake Macquarie, Maitland, Port Stephens, Cessnock, Dungog, Singleton and Muswellbrook Local Government Areas (LGA's), it should be noted that the following stay at home rules also apply:

Stay at home rules apply if you were in the local government areas of Newcastle, Cessnock, Dungog, Lake Macquarie, Maitland, Muswellbrook, Port Stephens or Singleton on or after Saturday 31 July 2021.

If you have left the area, you must follow the stay at home rules until 11:59 pm on Thursday 12 August 2021.

Any licensed participant who is affected by these stay at home rules is also required to provide a negative COVID test result to HRNSW Stewards prior to attending any harness racing meeting or trials.

Participants are reminded of Australian Harness Racing Rule 238:

AHRR 238 – A person shall not fail to comply with any order, direction or requirement of the Controlling Body or the Stewards relating to harness racing or the harness racing industry.
