

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) - TRAVEL REGISTRATION

AUGUST 27 2021

From 12.01am on Saturday 28 August 2021, licensed participants are required to register their travel through the Service NSW website when leaving or entering a local Government area (LGA) of concern.

You will require a Service NSW account which can be obtained at the following link: <u>https://account.service.nsw.gov.au/</u>

For the purposes of harness racing, if you reside in a local government area of concern, of the options available for the reason for travel, the most appropriate option would be 'Authorised worker'.

If you reside outside of a local government area of concern, of the options available for the reason for travel, the most appropriate option would be 'Other worker'.
