

NOTICE – HORSES HOPPLED TO UNHOPPLED (or vice versa)

REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSES TO RACE UNHOPPLED (OR REVERT BACK TO BEING HOPPLED):

A - For a horse to compete unhoppled after qualifying to race hoppled, the following conditions must be met.

- 1. The horse must trial satisfactorily unhoppled in <u>TWO</u> consecutive official trials;
- 2. When nominating for an official trial the Trainer will notify HRNSW that the horse is trialling for the purpose of qualifying to race unhoppled;
- 3. Prior to acceptance for any race the Trainer will lodge a Gear Form with HRNSW notifying the change to race unhoppled; and
- 4. Prior to any race, a period of fourteen (14) days will have expired since the horse last raced.

Note: "Consecutive official trials" in 1 above does not permit a horse to have a race start when between official trials.

B - Where a horse has raced unhoppled and the Trainer seeks to again race the horse hoppled, the following conditions must be met.

- 1. The horse must trial satisfactorily in <u>ONE</u> official trial, whilst hoppled;
- 2. When nominating for an official trial the Trainer will notify HRNSW that the horse is trialling for the purpose of qualifying to race hoppled;
- 3. Prior to acceptance for any race the Trainer will lodge a Gear Form with HRNSW notifying the change to race with hopples; and
- 4. Prior to any race, a period of seven (7) days will have expired since the horse last raced.
