## **NOTICE TO INDUSTRY**

## PHYSICAL THERAPIES AS TREATMENT

HRNSW consider certain physical and complementary therapies to be treatments which should <u>not</u> be administered on the day of racing.

Physical Treatments which should not be given on race day include, but are not limited to;

- Acupuncture (Including laser treatment)
- Magnetic Field Therapy and any other form of electrical stimulation
- Transcutaneous Electrical Nerve Stimulations (TENS)
- Ultrasound
- Extra-Corporeal Shock Wave (ESWT) treatment of horses is prohibited for seven (7) clear days prior to racing AHRR 213B.











## Relevant Rules;

AHRR 193 (3) A person shall not administer or allow or cause to be administered any medication to a horse on race day prior to such horse running in a race.

<u>AHRR 193 (5)</u> The Stewards shall order the withdrawal or disqualification of a horse that has been either treated or attempted to have been treated in breach of sub-rules (1), (2) and (3).

<u>AHRR 193 (6)</u> For the purposes of this Rule, medication means any treatment with drugs or other substances.

AHRR 193 (7) A person shall not allow or permit another person to attempt to perform or perform any of the actions prohibited by sub-rules (1), (2) or (3).

AHHR 193 (8) A person who fails to comply with sub-rules (1), (2), (3) or (7) is guilty of an offence.
