ELIGIBILITY IN CARNIVAL OF CUPS MEETINGS

1. BACKGROUND

1.1 This policy sets the rules with respect to which horses are eligible to contest Carnival of Cups Meetings.

2. **POLICY**

2.1 Eligibility

- a) Australian Bred horses are the only horses eligible to contest 2YO, 3YO, C0, C1, C2, C3 and C4 class events.
- b) All horses will be eligible to contest C5 or better events.

At Carnival of Cups meetings races are to be programmed for horses up to C4 and may also include a race or races for C5 or better horses.

For Example a program may look as below:

Class of Race	Horses Eligible
2YO	Australian Bred Horses
3YO	Australian Bred Horses
Maiden	Australian Bred Horses
C0	Australian Bred Horses
C1	Australian Bred Horses
C2	Australian Bred Horses
C3/C4	Australian Bred Horses
C5 or better	All Horses

Clause 2.1 a) and Clause 2.1 b) also apply to Heats for Finals to be conducted at Carnival of Cups race meetings.

2.2 Concessions

Mares and Driver Concessions apply in accordance with the relevant Policies.

For Example:

Mare Concessions

An Australian Bred mare assessed C2 or better will automatically drop one (1) class in any C1 or better front race (i.e. A C3 mare will be assessed as a C2 horse).

An Australian Bred mare assessed C5 or better can use two (2) claims in C3 or better front races (i.e. A C6 mare will be assessed as a C4 horse if a Concession Driver is declared prior to the close of nominations).

Any mare assessed C7 or better can use two (2) claims in C5 or better front races (i.e. A C8 mare will be assessed as a C6 horse if a Concession Driver is declared prior to the close of nominations).

Driver Concessions

An Australian Bred horse assessed C2 or better will drop one (1) class in any C1 or better front race when a Concession Driver is declared prior to the close of nominations (i.e. A C3 Gelding will be assessed as a C2 horse if a Concession Driver is declared prior to the close of nominations).

Any horse assessed C6 or better will drop one (1) class in any C5 or better front race when a Concession Driver is declared prior to the close of nominations (i.e. A C7 Gelding will be assessed as a C6 horse if a Concession Driver is declared prior to the close of nominations).
